At Wellsprings we believe that caring for the planet is central to our mission of educating thoughtful, responsible world citizens. We are committed to integrating environmental stewardship, social responsibility, and sound governance into every aspect of school life—teaching, operations, and community engagement.

Our Commitments:

- Learning and culture: We embed sustainability across the curriculum and co-curricular programs, fostering critical thinking, climate literacy, and a spirit of stewardship. Students learn by doing through outdoor education, service learning, clubs, and student-led initiatives.
- Climate and resources: We work to reduce our greenhouse gas emissions and conserve resources. This includes improving energy efficiency, transitioning to renewable energy where feasible, minimizing waste through reduction, reuse, recycling, and composting, and using water responsibly.
- Healthy, resilient campus: We manage our grounds and facilities to support biodiversity, indoor air quality, and the well-being of students and staff. We prioritize sustainable purchasing, non-toxic materials, and responsible food systems.

Targets:

- Reduce scope 1 and 2 emissions by 50% by 2030 from a 2023 baseline; achieve net-zero operations by 2040.
- Divert 80% of campus waste from landfill by 2028.
- Cut potable water use per student by 30% by 2030.

Governance:

- Annual reporting to the Board and community ensures oversight and continuous improvement.
